Light Industrial District – The Commission suggested that the properties between Custom Milling and Evansville Road be considered for a light industrial zoning district. The properties abut the existing Industrial District. By keeping everything in the same area, road improvements could be made that benefits everyone.

Traditional Neighborhood Design – After some discussion, the Commission determined that the design of the Villages of Blandon and Molltown did not lend themselves to a Traditional Neighborhood Design concept. Issues such as parking will be investigated further by implementing zoning regulations that would allow redevelopment of sites in the Villages.
