#### **Public Comment**

Jim Fisher and Skip Wagonseller of Trinity Bible fellowship Church asked the Planning Commission for direction on adding space to their facility on Main Street in Blandon. The Church is in need of classroom space and storage and would eventually like to add on to the back of current building. In the interim, they would like to bring in two modular units. The recorded land development plan has an area for expansion but that is not where they are currently looking to put the addition or modulars. Mr. Fisher asked the Commission what the Church's next step should be.

Tom Unger stated that the recorded Land Development Plan accounted for parking and storm water of the structure that was built and the proposed expansion. All the parking has been constructed. Mr. Unger recommended that since the proposed project does not exceed the expansion on the plan, that the Township handle the project with building and zoning permits. The Township Solicitor may want an agreement in place requiring the temporary modulars be removed when an addition is built or require a land development plan if the modulars become permanent and the Church wants to add space in addition to the modulars.

A motion was made by David Anspach, seconded by Matt Davenport, recommending that the Board of Supervisors allow the Trinity Bible fellowship Church to add temporary modulars to their property through a building and zoning permit and memorialize other requirements for their removal or construction of additional facilities with an agreement that is satisfactory to the Township Solicitor. Hearing no questions on the motion, all members voted, "Aye." Motion carried. The Secretary will add Mr. Fisher to the Supervisors' December 13<sup>th</sup> meeting agenda.
