

Maidencreek Township Board of Supervisor Meeting
July 14, 2016

Mr. Rudderow III convened the Public Hearing at 7:00 p.m. and turned the hearing over to Mr. Orlando, solicitor for Maidencreek Township.

Mr. Orlando stated that this was the time set aside to consider an ordinance titled “An Ordinance of the Township of Maidencreek, Berks County, Pennsylvania, amending the Code of Ordinances (Ordinance 223) of the Township authorizing the Township to join with other local government units as a settlor of the Pennsylvania Local Government Investment Trust for the purpose of purchasing shares of the Trust.

Mr. Orlando explained that the purpose of the ordinance was to allow the township to participate in PLIGIT, which authorizes the township to handle money like a local bank. The draft ordinance 240 was posted in the Township building. There was no public comment on the ordinance. The Board of Supervisors had no comment. Mr. Orlando announced that the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors would immediately follow and the Board did intend to consider and adopt Ordinance 240. The hearing was adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
