Roy Timpe called the emergency management meeting of the Maidencreek Township Board of Supervisors to order at 7:03 p.m. at the Maidencreek Township Municipal Building.

August 12, 2005 Activation of the EOC

Roy Timpe asked the secretary to place this item on the July 14, 2005 Supervisors agenda. Chief Eaken stated that there would be a Countywide drill taking place on September 24, 2005. The Chief is participating in the planning, since he will not be available to participate that day.

Equipment

Roy Timpe questioned if the Township should have a spare set of electronic parts for the generators and a dozen radios wrapped in aluminum foil and placed in a metal box. Another suggestion was to build a shed for emergency supplies recommended by FEMA. Mr. Timpe asked the secretary to place this item on the agenda also.

Dan Miller suggested purchasing a mobile command truck. The truck should have air conditioning, heat, radio, fax machine and electric. Roy Timpe suggested a trailer instead of a truck and using the Township truck to pull the unit where needed. Jim Schoellkopf suggested purchasing a walk in rescue truck. Temple has a unit and the windows in it are a nice feature. There may be grants available. Roy Timpe asked Keith Shuman to research grants for this type of project and Diane Hollenbach to see if this can be rolled into the budget.

Scott Eaken asked that the automatic light triggering system be looked at for the traffic lights.

Todd Bubbenmoyer asked if it would be a good idea to sit down and try to plan for different scenarios. Scott Eaken suggested that Todd contact the Berks EMA to see if they have done this already before the Township duplicates their work.

Since there was no further business, the emergency management meeting was adjourned at 7:49 p.m.
