Approval of the Agenda

Business:

5G and Small Cell Facilities – Ed Kopicki proposed a 100ft setback for the devices. Dave Brown made a motion to recommend that the Maidencreek Township Board of Supervisors accept the Proposed Code Amendment to Section 220-81. Matt Davenport seconded the motion and hearing no questions on the motion, it passed unanimously.

Definition of Shooting Range – Ed Kopicki distributed examples for the Board to review of other municipal zoning ordinance definitions for a shooting range. Gene Orlando urged the Board to define shooting range and address which zoning district it would be appropriate in. Dave Brown suggested we speak to Perry Township about Wing Pointe for a general guide with regulations. Randy Hauk will ask the President of Fleetwood Fish and Game to speak at the August Planning Commission meeting to assist with questions the Board may have. The Board asked the Township staff to purchase the NRA Source Book as an additional guide.

A motion was made by Randy Hauk to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Matt Davenport and hearing no questions on the motion, it passed unanimously.
