

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS AND TAXPAYERS OF MAIDENCREEK TOWNSHIP

Notice is given that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Maiden creek, Berks County, PA, will hold a public hearing, followed by a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors on September 10, 2020 at 7:00 P.M. at the Maiden creek Township Building, 1 Quarry Road, Blandon, PA 19510, the purpose of which is to inform the public, obtain public comment AND to adopt an Ordinance amending the Maiden creek Township Code of Ordinances by amending Chapter 204 of the Code entitled Vehicles and Traffic, to remove prohibited parking on Independence Court. The full text of the Ordinance is set forth below. At the conclusion of the public hearing, the Supervisors will immediately convene their regular monthly meeting during which they intend to adopt this same Ordinance. The Ordinance may be examined without charge or copies obtained for actual cost of copying of the same at the Maiden creek Township Municipal Building, 1 Quarry Road, Blandon, PA 19510, between the hours of 8:30 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. Monday through Friday. All interested parties may appear and be heard.

ORDINANCE NO. 252

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAIDENCREEK, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CHAPTER 204, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, TO REMOVE PROHIBITED PARKING ON INDEPENDENCE COURT.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Maiden creek, as follows:

Section 1. Section 204-15 of Chapter 204, Vehicles and Traffic of the Code of the Township of Maiden creek is hereby amended to remove the parking prohibition on Independence Court.

Section 2. Severability.

The provisions of this Article shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be unconstitutional, illegal, such decision shall not affect the validity of any remaining provisions of this Article. It is hereby declared that it is the legislative intent that this Article would have been adopted had the unconstitutional or illegal provision had not been included.

Section 3. Repealer.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from the date of enactment.
