MAIDENCREEK TOWNSHIP FOR 2017.


WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Maiden creek Township to insure the public safety of the residents of Maiden creek Township in the area of emergency medical transport service for 2017.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Maiden creek, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

The Blandon Community Ambulance Association is authorized to provide such services to the municipality as may be necessary for the protection of the health and welfare of persons located within the Township of Maiden creek and respond to out-of-jurisdiction calls that include but are not limited to the prevention of loss of life and response to medical emergencies for 2017.

All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar, but only insofar, as the same are inconsistent herewith.
