## RESOLUTION 12-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAIDENCREEK, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE BLANDON VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY NO 1 TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE FOR THE PROPERTIES AND PERSONS OF MAIDENCREEK TOWNSHIP FOR 2013.

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Maidencreek Township to insure the public safety of the residents of Maidencreek Township in the area of fire protection for 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Maidencreek, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

- 1. The Blandon Volunteer Fire Company is authorized to provide such services to the municipality as may be necessary for the protection of property and persons located within the Township of Maidencreek and respond to out-of-jurisdiction calls that include but are not limited to the extinguishment and prevention of loss of life and property from fire and also the extinguishment and prevention of fires associated with but not limited to automobile accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous materials incidents and other situations which require fire fighting for 2014.
- 2. The agreement of Blandon Fire Company No. 1 to provide services as set forth herein is evidenced by its letter delivered to the Township and attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

3. All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby repealed insofar, but only insofar, as the same are inconsistent herewith.

Dear Mr. Miller,

The purpose of this letter is to set forth the agreement of Blandon Fire Company No. 1 ("the Company") to provide fire fighting services to Maidencreek Township as follows: the Company will provide emergency fire service to the municipality as may be necessary for the protection of property and persons located within the Township of Maidencreek and respond to out-of-jurisdiction calls. Duties include but are not limited to: the extinguishment and prevention of loss of life and property from fire, the extinguishment and prevention of fires associated with, but not limited to, automobile accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous materials incidents and other situations that require fire fighting, and adequate training of its membership as required by Federal, State and Local Government agencies.

The Township will provide the following:

- 1. a semi annual contribution, which will be determined each year as part of the Township's budget process,
- 2. payment of 911 operational costs,
- 3. fuel,
- 4. insurance coverage on the Company's vehicles,
- 5. Workman's Compensation Insurance for the Company's membership,

The Company shall provide on a monthly basis the following:

- 1. a copy of the Company's Treasurer's Report that was presented to the last meeting of the Company's membership,
- 2. a list of members active within the Company that month,
- 3. a call report which includes all incidents responded to and training completed,
- 4. the mileage and general condition of each vehicle insured by the Township,
- 5. gallons of gas taken from the Township fuel tanks for each vehicle.
