

RESOLUTION 15- 2018

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MAIDENCREEK, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING THE MANAGER AS CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE NON-UNIFORMED EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT PLAN AND THE CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AS CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER IN THE ABSENCE OF A MANAGER.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Maidenecreek, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

WHEREAS, the Maidenecreek Township Board of Supervisors has established a non-uniformed employee retirement plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to appoint the Township Manager as Chief Administrative Officer under said retirement plan and grant said Chief Administrative Officer the primary responsibility for the execution of the administrative affairs of said retirement plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires that in the absence of the manager, the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors shall act as the Chief Administrative Officer of the pension plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Maidenecreek, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it hereby is resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Supervisors of the Township of Maidenecreek hereby appoints the Township Manager as the Chief Administrative Officer of the Maidenecreek Township Non-Uniform Pension Plan which was restated and adopted by Resolution 21-2012. The Chief Administrative Officer shall have the primary responsibility for the execution of the administrative affairs of said retirement plan. In the absence of the Township Manager, the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors shall act as Chief Administrative Officer of the Pension Plan.

Section 2. All resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with the Resolution are hereby repealed insofar, but only insofar, as the same are inconsistent herewith.

Section 3. The effective date of this Resolution shall be the date that the same is signed by the Board of Supervisors.
