

## EMERGENCY NOTIFICATION PROCEDURES

State regulations require that customers of the Maidencreek Township Authority (MTA) be notified within 24 hours of a water emergency situation. In order to comply with the regulations, the MTA has entered into a contract with a company called **Swift911** to provide the Township with an automated telephone notification service. The system will only be activated during **emergency** situations. During the most recent emergency, we discovered that many of the phone numbers we had were disconnected because people have moved away from using a landline and had not provided us with their cell phone number in the past.
