As instructed by the notice on the Maiden Creek Township's web page, I'm responding to; creating a resolution to oppose the 222 roundabouts.

Reinstate the resolution by Supervisor Heidi Fiedler at the March 8, 2018 Maiden Creek Township Supervisors meeting, to hire a Consultant/Expert by the township to address, clarify, recommend, etc, to the board of Supervisors and township residents, in regard for how to oppose the construction and maintenance agreement for the traffic circles at Schaffer Rd and Genius/Tamarack roads.

The resolution by Supervisor Fiedler, was ignored by the Chairman after minimal discussion. The discussion was, hiring a consultant will raise taxes. The public countered with suggesting to hire a consultant with a reasonable dollar amount to be spent without raising taxes and provide a legal report on the roundabout subject.

The Board of Supervisors has stated they are too unfamiliar with how the township and state's policies, regarding responsibilities for 222 and other state roads within in the township will affect the township's funding, i.e. liquid fuels because, we are in opposition to building/maintaining roundabouts in the township.

Since our taxes will inevitably be increased due to the town bearing the cost and liability of the long term maintenance responsibilities and utilities relocation for the two roundabouts, hiring a consultant/expert on the subject is warranted.
