# MAIDENCREEK TOWNSHIP BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA RESOLUTION NO. 11 – 2023

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING BLANDON VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY NO. 1 AS THE PRIMARY PROVIDER OF FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION SERVICES FOR PROPERTIES AND PERSONS FOR 2023.

**WHEREAS** it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Maidencreek Township to contribute to the public safety of the residents of Maidencreek Township for fire protection and prevention for 2023;

**NOW, THEREFORE** be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Maidencreek, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same as follows:

### Section 1 - Designation of Primary Emergency Medical and Ambulance Services Provider

The Maidencreek Township Board of Supervisors hereby designates the Blandon Volunteer Fire Company No. 1 whose principal office is located at 36 W. Wesner Road, Blandon, PA 19510.

#### Section 2 - Term of Office

The term of this designation shall be from this third day of January 2023 AD until the next Maidencreek Township Reorganization Meeting to be held the third day of January 2024 AD.

#### **Section 3 - Agreement for Service**

The agreement of Blandon Volunteer Fire Company No. 1 to provide services as set forth herein is evidenced by its letter delivered to the Township and attached to this Resolution as Appendix A and incorporated herein.

## **Section 4 - Delegation of Authority**

The Blandon Volunteer Fire Company is designated as the primary provider of fire protection and prevention services to the municipality as may be necessary for the protection of property and persons located within the Township of Maidencreek. They may respond to out-of-jurisdiction calls that include, but are not limited to, the extinguishment and prevention of loss of life or property from fire, and also the extinguishment and prevention of fires associated with but not limited to automobile accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous materials incidents and other situations which require their response.

Wise Duties include but are not limited to the extinguishment and prevention of loss of life and property from fire; the extinguishment and prevention of fires associated with, but not limited to, automobile accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous materials incidents and other situations that require fire fighting; and adequate training of its membership as required by Federal, State and Local Government agencies.

The Township will provide the following:

- 1. A fire tax of .4 mills to cover expenses allowed by the Second Class Township Code;
- 2. Fuel; and
- 3. Insurance coverage on the Company's vehicles.

The Company shall provide on a monthly basis the following:

- 1. Copy of bills attached to a reimbursement request to be paid in accordance with the Second Class Township Code;
- 2. A copy of the Company's Treasurer's Report that was presented to the last meeting of the Company's membership;
- 3. A list of members active within the Company that month;
- 4. A call report which includes all incidents responded to and training completed;
- 5. The mileage and general condition of each vehicle insured by the Township; and
- 6. Gallons of gas taken from the Township fuel tanks for each vehicle.
